EFFECTIVE ON OCTOBER 1, 2023 ICD-10-CM Diagnosis Codes Are Available for Desmoid Tumors

Desmoid tumors are rare, locally aggressive soft tissue tumors that are proliferative, can be debilitating, disfiguring, and potentially life-threatening in rare cases when vital organs are impacted.1

Initial misdiagnosis of desmoid tumors occurs in approximately 30% to 40% of cases,² and these diagnostic delays may be reduced through timely and accurate coding.

Until October 1, 2023, desmoid tumors fell under an ICD-10-CM code (D48.1) covering a variety of connective and soft tissue tumors of "uncertain behavior."⁴

The availability of location-specific ICD-10-CM codes may help:



Support increased identification of patients with desmoid tumors



Improve visibility into the journey of patients with desmoid tumors

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Enable healthcare providers to appropriately document diagnosis of patients with desmoid tumors
